

The Stephenson Hall Association, University of Sheffield

Constitution

- 1 The Association shall be called “The Stephenson Hall Association”.
- 2 The aims of the Association shall be as follows:
 - i) To provide the means of maintaining contact between former members of Stephenson Hall and between them and present members.
 - ii) To keep members informed of events and progress at Stephenson Hall.
- 3 Membership shall be of four kinds:
 - i) Ordinary membership: which shall be confined to former members of Stephenson Hall, University of Sheffield, who have paid the current life subscription.
 - ii) Student membership: which shall be confined to current and former members of Stephenson Hall Junior Common Room whose student membership subscription has been paid by the JCR. This class of membership will lapse not more than four years after the member’s JCR subscription lapses, from when the member will be eligible for Ordinary membership.
 - iii) Honorary membership: present members of the Senior Common Room other than those eligible for ordinary membership, and the officers of the Junior Common Room at Stephenson Hall. Honorary members have the right to attend meetings, but shall have no voting rights.
 - iv) Honorary life membership: to be presented by unanimous vote at an Annual General Meeting.
- 4 The life and student subscriptions to the Association shall be as decided from time to time at the Annual General Meeting.
- 5 An Annual General Meeting shall be held in the summer vacation. An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be called at the request of any 15 members, to take place not less than 3 weeks and not more than 6 weeks after the date of the receipt of this request by the Honorary secretary. Members must be given at least two weeks notice of any General Meeting and must at the same time be informed of the agenda.
- 6 The officers of the Association shall be a President, Secretary and Treasurer. The officers shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting from among the ordinary members of the Association; casual vacancies in those offices shall be filled by persons appointed by the committee to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting. The Treasurer shall be authorised to receive and sign cheques on behalf of the Association.
- 7 The affairs of the Association shall be managed by an Executive Committee consisting of two or more members elected at the Annual General Meeting, together with the officers, and any honorary life members elected at an Annual General Meeting.

8 Amendments to this constitution shall take place at General Meetings only, and must be carried by a vote of two thirds of the members present. Proposals for such amendments must be notified on the circulated agenda for the meeting. A quorum for a General Meeting shall be 10 ordinary members.
